The founder established his firm in 2000 in NYC, Paris in 2006 and Sion in 2017. He has worked with eight Pritzker architects on four continents continents and lived/worked 30 years abroad, from Japan, USA, France to Switzerland. He was awarded Best Building of the Year, 2013 for co-authoring the Louvre-Lens.

He was an associate of Jean Nouvel's during the early years of his practice, associate-partner for I.M. Pei on three independent projects, and senior museum architect for Herzog & de Meuron among others. He joint-ventured with SANAA on two museum projects, and has collaborated with 10 leading engineers and artists on international invited museum competitions. In addition to architecture, he has designed bridges, landscapes, lighting, exhibitions and furniture. Culbert is an UNESCO heritage expert and UNDP professional. He is co-director of an art residency in Corsica and in the Valais that he helped establish.
